# Registered Provisional Psychologist

## Essential requirements

**You must be a Registered Provisional Psychologist with the College of Alberta Psychologists with interest or experience working with children and/or couples.**

## Job description

As a Registered Provisional Psychologist with the College of Alberta Psychologists:

- You will practice under the supervision of a Registered Psychologist, as described under the Health Professions Act.
- You will provide counselling services to children, adolescents, families, and/or couples. You do not need to work with all populations, but you must serve one of the groups listed.
- You will provide in-person or telepsychology (telehealth) counselling services, to clients assigned to you based on your knowledge, skills, training, qualifications, and expertise.
- You will be responsible for the following, as necessary and required:
  - Treatment planning, including establishing goals and outcomes, evaluating client needs, and/or conducting client assessments.
  - Service preparation, including but not limited to providing client resources, conducting research, or direct billing on behalf of clients.
  - Case management, including scheduling sessions, responding to client requests via email and phone.
  - File management, including record keeping/progress notes, invoicing and billing.
  - Case consultation and supervision.
- You must comply with Health Professions Act and the standards of practice, practice guidelines and code of ethics of the College of Alberta Psychologists.

## How to apply

**We encourage a diverse pool of candidates to apply.** Research has found that many stellar candidates (typically, women or diverse candidates) do not apply for jobs at which they would excel, unless they are 100% certain that they fulfill all the criteria listed in a job posting. That means the world is missing out on some outstanding talent. Although we cannot change that everywhere, we want to do what we can to bring about change in our tiny corner of the world. We encourage you to apply (for this job, or any other amazing job at which you feel you could be amazing) if you fulfill the essential requirements.
